and third countries not associated to the Programme**

The institutions named below agree to cooperate for the exchange of staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. This agreement is valid for the Erasmus+ call years 20[21]-20[27] in:

- KA131
- KA171

UAM and, when applicable, the partner institution commit to sound and transparent management of funds allocated to them through Erasmus+ and to respect the quality requirements of the Programme, outlined in the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education¹ and in this agreement.

The institutions agree on exchanging their mobility-related data according to the principles of GDPR² and in line with the technical standards of the European Student Card Initiative³, WHEN this becomes available for international mobility involving third countries not associated to the Programme.

Sending institutions located in EU/EEA countries must ensure compliance with the provisions of art. 46 GDPR for all participants' personal data exchanged in the context of their mobility with institutions from non-EU/EEA countries without an adequacy decision, on the condition that enforceable data subject rights and effective legal remedies for data subjects are available in the respective third country. The participants should be informed in a transparent manner about the level of protection of their personal data, if this is different from the one where the sending institution is located.

2. Mobility numbers per academic year

STAFF MOBILITY: staff mobility between partner universities is agreed on a case-by-case basis, and each mobility must have the approval of the relevant host department/unit.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: UAM outgoing staff may be funded, if funds available, by the Erasmus+ Programme. In case UAM receives funds to finance incoming mobility, it will be immediately communicated to the partner university.

3. Recommended language skills

The sending institution, following agreement with the receiving institution, is responsible for providing support to its nominated candidates so that they can have the recommended [language skills](#)⁶ at the start of the mobility period (see also section 5 “Preparation and Support”).
