Sant'Anna, André, Christopher Jude McCarroll, and Kourken Michaelian, eds. 2023. *Current Controversies in Philosophy of Memory*. London: Routledge.

Regarding philosophical methods, we will explore proposals from the book:

Burgess, Alexis, Herman Cappelen, and David Plunkett, eds. 2020. *Conceptual Engineering and Conceptual Ethics*. Oxford: Oxford University Press.

Considering the goal of opening postdoc and publishing opportunities for the students of our Graduate Program, the course will be presented in English. Still, the students can feel free to speak and write in Portuguese.

Evaluation:

- Weekly written reactions to the assigned readings (50% of the grade),
- The first draft of a paper about mnemonicity (1,000–1,500 words, 25% of the grade),
- The final version (2,500–4,000 words, 25% of the grade).
