

Do you need help improving your Spanish before starting your semester abroad?

Universidad de Congreso wants to invite you to have a great international experience learning Spanish in Mendoza.

During the month of July we're opening a *pre-arrival* Argentine Culture and Language Course for those students who have been accepted as exchange students and want to improve their language skills taking intensive Spanish.

We can also arrange this or other Spanish for foreigners programs any time of the year.

Argentine Culture and Language Course

The course starts 3 weeks before the first day of the semester approximately: last week of February or second week of July. It consists of **60 hours of Spanish classes** (4 hours a day), which will allow you to advance one whole level, for example: from intermediate to advanced.

Those students who attend all three weeks of class and who complete the required assignments, receive academic credit for the class on their official UC transcript.

Location

The program takes place at Intercultural, our Foreign Language Institute, conveniently located in downtown Mendoza, 4 blocks away from UC. This facility is fully equipped with classrooms and a computer lab.

Sample List of Field Trips and Activities

The program also includes excursions to important touristic and cultural attractions while taking the course.

- Bus city tour through the most relevant areas of Mendoza.
- Half Day Wine Tour in Luján de Cuyo.

Health Insurance

Students are required to have international health insurance for their exchange semester at UC. Those who choose to take the Argentine Culture and Language Course, are also required to have their insurance cover those 3 weeks.

Cost
